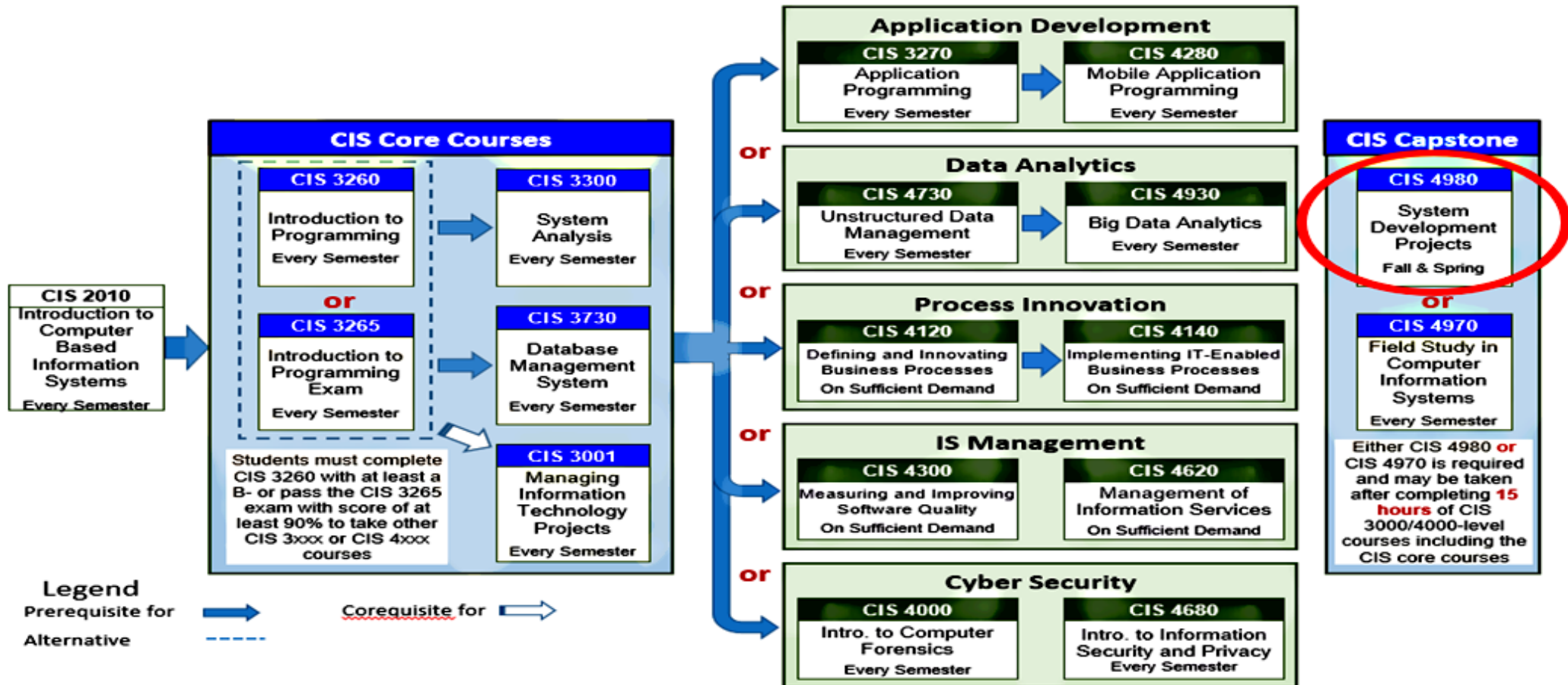

 - In-person classes & meetings with the faculty

Typical Student Projects

➤ Research & Analysis

- Analyze user requirements and propose IT solutions
- Evaluate business processes and IT operations and security policies and propose improvement suggestions

➤ Development

- Design and develop proof of concept (POC) or prototype systems
- Augment to organization's dev teams on specific tasks

➤ Implementation

- Assist in different phases of system implementation projects such as project management, user training, etc.



Responsibilities of Project Sponsors

- **Define requirements, scope, and deliverables (1 Page Project Request)**
- **Supervise student work**
 - Meet the team weekly and offer guidance
 - Review project plans and weekly updates to offer timely feedback
 - Answer student questions
 - Coordinate internal resources
 - Alert the faculty of issues and problems
- **Evaluate student/project team performance**
 - Midterm feedback to the students
 - Final evaluation (40% of the course grade)
