The Georgia Cyber Innovation and Training Center is a state-owned facility designed to promote modernization in cybersecurity technology for private and public industries through unique education, training, research, and practical applications.

The state-of-the-art center represents a unique public/private partnership that includes Augusta University, Augusta Technical College, the University System of Georgia's research institutions, the City of Augusta, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, and other state, federal and private-sector partners.

Located in Augusta, Georgia, a growing cybersecurity area that's home to the U.S. Army Cyber Command and Cyber School of Excellence at Fort Gordon, the center will serve as an incubator for cybersecurity companies and help fill the current and growing shortage of cybersecurity talent in the state and nation.
